Shaykh Ibn Uthaymeen (رَحِمَهُ اللَّهُ)¹ said, “It befits a person to always inspect himself as to whether he is upright or not, if he is then he praises Allaah (عزوجل)² and extols Him and asks Him to keep him firm [upon that righteousness], and if he is not upright he must become upright and he must change [the manner of] his progression to Allaah (عزوجل).”³
