

With regards to the conditions for an action to be correct, the Shaykh Muhammad ibn Saalih al 'Uthaymeen (رَحِمَهُ اللهُ) states:

Sixthly – that the action conforms with the Sharee'ah in makaan (location). So if a person made i'tikaaf in other than the mosques in that he made i'tikaaf in the school or in the house, then his i'tikaaf is not correct because it did not conform with the Sharee'ah in the location of the i'tikaaf. So the location of i'tikaaf is the mosques.
