Shaykh Ibn Uthaymeen (رَحِمَهُ الله)<sup>1</sup> said, "The statement made about a dead person that, 'He has been buried in his final resting place,' is haraam and not permissible, since when you say, '... in his final resting place,' then according to that the grave is the last thing for him, and that implies a denial of the Resurrection."<sup>2</sup>
