Shaykh Ibn Uthaymeen (رَحِمَهُ اللهُ) said, "The Most High's Saying,

'But the enduring good deeds are better before your Lord for reward and better for [one's] hope,'2

'... enduring good deeds ...' are good statements or actions, like [saying], 'Subhaanallaah,' 'Alhamdulillaah,' 'Laa ilaaha illallaah,' 'Allaahu Akbar,' and, 'Laa hawla wa laa quwwata illa billaah,' and [are things like] giving charity, fasting, ordering the good and forbidding the evil and other such things – these, '... enduring good deeds ...' are, '... better before your Lord for reward ...' i.e., recompense and requital, and, '... better for [one's] hope ...' i.e., the best thing a person can hope for."
