In the Name of Allaah the most Kind the most Merciful

Shaykh Ibn Uthaymeen (رَحْمَهُ اللهُ)¹ said, "A very beneficial statement has been reported from 'Umar ibn al-Khattaab (رَحْمَهُ اللهُ عنه)² which is, 'Whoever has been blessed in something, let him stick to it,' an amazing statement which if weighed against gold would outweigh it. Ya'nee [it means] when a person performs an action and he sees the blessing and the fruits [of carrying it out] he should stick to it. We can give an example of this through the condition of the student of knowledge who has started studying a book or revising it and who finds abundant good and finds that he is benefitting and profiting [from it], so we say to him, 'Stick to that and finish it and don't say, 'This is [just] an abridged, small book.'"³
